

# Willow Tree Class: Summer 2017 Curriculum Overview

## Literacy and Phonics

- SPaG sessions will be taught as discrete lessons throughout the week
- To practice handwriting
- To practice reading and comprehension skills
- Narrative writing including stories, diary writing and newspaper articles
- Poetry writing
- Non-fiction writing including Stuart London descriptions through creative curriculum links

## Mathematics

- Number, place value and rounding
- To add and subtract numbers mentally and using written methods
- To recognise the relationships between numbers (e.g. the inverse)
- To solve problems using known facts
- To recall and use multiplication and division facts for times tables 2, 5, 10 and 3s
- To multiply and divide numbers, understanding that they are the inverse
- To find, name and write simple fractions
- Data handling/ Statistics
- Geometry - position and direction
- Geometry - properties of shapes
- Time, money and measures

## French

Will not be taught as a discrete lesson but over the year the children will learn some vocabulary and phrases.

## Science

Through geography link:

- To work scientifically to ask simple questions
- Observe closely using simple equipment
- Gather and record data to help answer simple questions
- To learn about living things and their habitats



## Music

- To play and perform music
- To listen to different music with attention to sounds
- To begin to appreciate different types of music

## Physical Education

- Invasion games
- Gym
- Dance

## PSHCE and RE

- To review our class charter
- Through circle time to discuss goals and targets
- RE - taught through links to other subjects such as art and literacy

## History and Geography

- To find out about the Great Fire of London
- To ask questions about the past
- To find out a little about the Stuart reign of Charles II
- To explore weather and climate in the UK and around the world
- To use fieldwork and observational skills

## Computing

- To code using Scratch and other programs
- To connect through blogs and emails
- Devise and construct databases
- To communicate ideas, work or messages professionally

## Art and DT

- Learn about some artists and designers from history
- To use a variety of media and skills including, collage, clay, painting and printing
- To use skills of planning, developing, improving, creating and evaluating
- To develop some art techniques including how to build up a painting, brush techniques and sketching
