## Health and Safety

Both school and The Ark have been monitoring the traffic entering the school at both drop off and pick up. We feel there has been great improvement and would like to thank you for responding to our concerns.

To keep traffic to a minimum we are still asking parents to park outside the school and walk in.

Please do not use the disabled spaces between the **8:30 -9:15** and **2:45 and 3: 45**. Parking on the yellow zig zags outside the school gates is also illegal and increases the risk to our children, as does parking in front of the entrance to The Ark.

We also ask that all pedestrians use the path and keep small children under close supervision.

The safety of our community is our top priority and the responsibility of us all; together we can ensure drop off and pick up remain a pleasant, calm and safe experience for all concerned. We will continue to regularly review the car park, as part of our self -evaluation procedures and highlight any concerns immediately. Thank you for your continued support.
