

Personal, Social and Emotional development (PSED)

Discussions about the needs of animals following some animal visits.

Discuss what we need to do to keep safe around animals

Knowledge and Understanding of the World (KUW) *includes science.

Communication, Language and Literacy (CLL)

4 x weekly Read, Write, Inc phonic sessions

Learn an oral retelling of *The Little Red Hen*.
Sequence the story of *The Enormous Turnip*
Instruction writing for growing vegetables

Farm inspired poetry.

Mathematics

Names of days of the week/months of the year

Addition and subtraction

Weight and capacity

Practise key skills i.e. counting reliably up to 20, recognising and ordering numbers to 20. Number formation practise.
