## RE Creation and Science-: conflicting or complementary?

- Place the concepts of God and Creation on a timeline of the Bibles 'Big Story'
- Make the links between Genesis 1 and what Christians believe about God and Creation
- Ask and answer questions about what might be important in the creation story for Christians living today and for non-Christians .

## Science Evolution and Inheritance

- Analyse the advantages and disadvantages of specific adaptations
- Recognise that living things have changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago.
- Recognise that living things produce offspring of the same kind, but normally offspring vary and are not identical to their parents.
- Identify how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways and that adaptation may lead to evolution.
